- Sign your Facility Use Agreement. A Facility Use Agreement will be provided to you once agreeable terms and dates are reached.

Building Options All lodges are heated/cooled and are ADA-accessible.

Valleyview Lodge // Valleyview Lodge accommodates up to 166 people in beds divided into thirteen sleeping areas with plenty of bathroom and shower facilities. The main room provides a 5,400-square-foot event space with 25-foot ceiling heights, allowing for groups of up to 400 people and features a modern worship center with an elevated stage completely updated recently. The worship center is fully equipped with

- Video
- Projection
- Lighting systems

Additional breakout meeting spaces and a half-kitchen accommodate a variety of



group sizes and arrangements. The entire lodge is heated, air-conditioned, and offers limited WiFi.

Lakeview Lodge // Lakeview Lodge accommodates up to 116 people in beds divided into ten sleeping areas with plenty of bathroom and shower facilities. The main room provides a 2,400-square-foot event space allowing for groups of up to 200 people and features a stage and full sound system. A full kitchen is provided for any cooking needs, along with a commercial coffee maker. Take in the beautiful views from the large deck with rocking chairs. Breakout space is also available in the finished half-basement. Have a fireside chat around the indoor gas fireplace. The entire lodge is heated, air-conditioned, and offers limited WiFi.

Joshua Lodge // Joshua Lodge accommodates up to 27 people in beds divided into eight sleeping areas with plenty of bathroom and shower facilities. The lodge is designed for small group meetings and retreats. Both sides of the lodge are complete with full kitchens and furnished living rooms with plenty of room for that card game and planning your next vision with your leadership team. The entire lodge is heated, air-conditioned, and offers limited WiFi.

Dogwood Cabin // Dogwood Cabin is located adjacent to the dining hall. The cabin has been upgraded to include a fully stocked First Aid Area and several bedrooms.

Maplewood Cabin // Maplewood Cabin is located near the lake and includes a front porch view of the lake. The cabin has been upgraded to include a fully furnished living room, dining room, and kitchen.

Dining Hall // The dining hall at Camp Illiana is a place of nourishment and fun! Each year, our campers and guests share their love for the great camp food. We enjoy blueberry muffins, taco Tuesday, chicken pasta, and camp cookies! These and other camp favorites are served as part of each balanced meal that is carefully crafted. The dining hall is both heated and air-conditioned with 3,642 square feet of space and includes a full commercial kitchen. This original building has been completely renovated and expanded. It is centrally located on the property and is designed to seat up to 220 people. The facility is also equipped with a complete sound system, video projection, and a beautiful stone gas fireplace for fireside chats.

Pavilion // The Pavilion is an open-air meeting and event facility conveniently located near the sports field and adjacent to wooded areas. The building was constructed in 2017 and is a beautiful event venue with 8,056 square feet. The building has a stunning stained wood finish, stained concrete with beautiful woods views and seats up to 450 people. The facility is equipped with dimmable lighting, dedicated



convenient general purpose receptacles, a complete sound system, and 100A main distribution with single cam lock connections.

Activities Options

The following activities options are offered for additional fees and are available depending on weather conditions.

Zip Lines // Camp Illiana's High Zip Lines takes campers on a fast 900-foot ride from the top of a four-story tower overlooking beautiful trees! Our kid zipline takes younger campers on a 300-foot ride exploring the wooded tree areas.

High Ropes Course // The High Ropes course will challenge your camper through gravity-defying fun! The courses are geared toward supporting campers achieving new challenges while being cheered on by their team. Trained facilitators and leaders will guide your camper through the high ropes elements.

Low Ropes Course // The Low Ropes course consists of a series of obstacles designed to challenge campers to work together as a team. Using cables, ropes, and wooden beams among trees and poles, campers explore risk-taking, leadership, and communication. Campers will walk tightropes, navigate obstacles, and have lots of fun and adventure.

Blob // Blobbing at Camp Illiana is an outdoor water activity in which a camper sits on the end of a partly inflated air bag (blob) and is launched into the water when another camper jumps onto the air bag from a platform on the opposite side.

Paintball // Get ready to battle it out in over 90,000 square feet of paintball fun! The paintball course showcases unique obstacles and forts to challenge even the expert players and offers hours of fun for Middle School ages and up. Campers are provided safety equipment, instruction, referees, paint, and guns for a great experience!

Climbing Wall // Located in the Valleyview Lodge, the climbing wall is designed to create an experience where campers can develop confidence and self-esteem and experience encouragement, support, trust, and teamwork through an exciting challenge. With four climbs on various pitches, there is a wide range of challenges available.

Swimming and Water Games // Camp is such a contrast to everyday life! Campers will experience crazy camp water wars with fun adventures. Swimming everyday allows time to enjoy the pool waterslide, inflatable slip-and-slides and foam cannons.



Kayaks + Paddle Boards // Campers may choose to slow down and take a relaxing float on our lake. With the option of both paddle boards and kayaks to choose from, there is plenty of fun to be had out on the water. Paddles and life jackets are provided.

Giant Swing // Campers playing on the Giant Swing are harnessed in and their team pulls them up to 35 feet in the air. Once the swinging participants are ready to fly, they release their tether and swing out over the lake!

Outdoor Games // Campers experience all the favorite camp outdoor games! Gaga Ball, Nine Square in the Air, Corn Hole, Frisbee Golf, Tether Ball, Four Square, Basketball, Soccer, Kick Ball, Giant Jenga, Connect Four, Ultimate Frisbee, Carpet Ball, Kan Jam, and so many more.

Food Service Options

You may take advantage of the camp's food service for a per person per meal charge. This charge varies according to the meal. When more than one group is using food service, it may be necessary to cooperate during meal times.

You may bring your own food and cooks and provide the meals yourself in one of our kitchens. You may also be able to rent the Dining Hall if you have a large group, depending on availability. The camp will provide all table service, pots, pans, utensils, ice, kitchen towels, dish soap, etc. If cooking for your group, you must bring anything consumable such as paper products, coffee, foil, and condiments.

Bedding and Towel Options

All of the lodging options do not include bedding or towel services; each person provides their own.
